John Whitehead and Barton Kale of the Division conducted a partial inspection of the above mentioned drill holes on August 31, 1982. The purpose of the inspection was to observe the status of the exploration sites in relation to reclamation and stabilization.

The inspectors found that the holes were not regraded, topsoiled, or seeded. The mud pits were evident and the holes were open. To be in compliance with the regulations of UMC 815 reclamation of the drill sites must be completed this fall.
