Dear Mr. Hedberg:

I am in receipt of your letter dated September 25, 1984. Due to the urgency of ending this matter and the unpredictability of Clear Creek weather, the Blazon # 3 drill road and site were reclaimed to as near original contour as possible and seeded as previously stated.

Sanders Exploration, Limited can do no more, as it is essentially bankrupt and has not issued a payroll since May 25, 1984. All employees, including myself, have been layed off and seeking other employment. My continued involvement has been out of my feeling of responsibility of seeing a job completed. SEL has no funds to purchase additional seeds at a quoted price of \$976.06/acre or complete any additional work.

SEL has been commended by Larry Dalton, UDWR and even some in your office for its previous reclamation of 1983 drill sites and roads. The Blazon road has been done in the same fashion.
