Dear Mr. Young:

Please accept this "Request for Permit Modification" for Blazon # 3 drill hole, Carbon County, Utah.

As stated in the original "Notice of Intent to Commence Coal Exploration", discussed and presented to Mr. T. Tetting, DOGM on November 16, 1983 during a conference in his office: "All constructed roads and sites will be reclaimed unless requested otherwise by the surface land owner or the Division or other government body with the authority to make such requests and the Division will be notified if the road is not reclaimed." In that conference and subsequent approval letter from Mr. Tetting, Sanders Exploration, Limited was granted permission to explore for coal in the manner outlined in the permit and thus assumes the entire permit was approved, including the above statement.

Will you please modify or ammend the Blazon # 3 permit to reflect that no reclamation will be undertaken as the landowner requests, as affirmed by Division Field Inspector Sandy Pruitt, that the road and drill site be left "as is" subsequent to exploration. In addition, Sanders Exploration, Limited requests that all ongoing reclamation liabilities which pertain to this hole be terminated and affirmed in writing.
