RE: Sunedco, Sage Point-Dugout Canyon Mine, ACT/007/009, folder #7, Carbon County, Utah

On July 10, 1984, an inspection of the Sage Point-Dugout Canyon Mine area was conducted by Ken Wyatt, Field Specialist for the Division. On June 5, 1984, this operation was granted final permanent program approval in a letter from Dianne Nielson. This permit was subsequently revised on June 15, 1984.

At this time no construction work has commenced in the proposed mining areas. According to conversations with Mr. Charlie Durrett of Sunedco, the company does not intend to commence mining activities until sometime in 1985. He further indicated that work to be done next year would probably involve the access road to Dugout Canyon as well as the portal area in Dugout Canyon. The company does not intend to construct facilities in Fish Creek or Sage Point.

During this inspection, no activity was observed up Dugout Canyon, Sage Point or Anderson Reservoir. There was no evidence of any recent mining activities and no compliance problems were encountered.
