A complete inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on August 21, 1985 by Barton Kale of the Division.

This inspection was conducted in response to a report by the company of a slide at one of the sealed portals. Apparently there was some chance of the portals opening so the operator brought a cat to the site to ensure the seal.

The upper pad on the south side had been worked as well as the lower pad. Some boulders had been placed at the access to the lower pad to restrict the entrance. An existing berm was used to unload the cat as was illustrated by the tracks. There were some tracks on the north side of the road as well although no work was observed. There seemed to be alot of movement for the amount of work done but no problems were noted.
