
The Division has reviewed the information submitted on September 20, 1984 and January 8, 1985 by Sunedco Coal Company in response to certain Stipulations to Permit Approval.

The Division finds that the information submitted is sufficient to answer stipulations 817.97-(3)-OSM8 (OSM Condition No. 12g), 817.99-(1)-SL (OSM Condition No. 14), 817.107-(1)-PGL (OSM Condition No. 15) and 817.122-.126-(1)-TNT (OSM Condition No. 17).

Stipulation 817.49(2)-DD/DWH (OSM Condition No. 4) was also addressed. While the Division found the response submitted to be satisfactory up to a point, the Division will not sign off on this Stipulation until final design plans for Dugout Reservoir have been submitted. This should be done at least 120 day prior to reservoir construction.
