

This letter is in regards to UMC 782.16(a), Relationship to Areas Designated Unsuitable for Mining;

- (a) Each application shall contain a statement of available information on whether the proposed permit area is within an area designated unsuitable for surface effects of underground coal mining activities under 30 CFR 764 and 765 and UMC 764 and 765, study for designation in an administrative proceeding initiated or under those Parts.
