Dear Mr. Elias:

Thank you for your letter concerning the proposed location of four new surface monitoring stations at the Hiawatha Complex, King Mines. We have also received a copy of your latest quarterly report of water quality analyses for the months of April, May and June, 1980.

I have reviewed the Hydrologic Monitoring Plan submitted by U.S. Fuel Company in December of 1979 and noted that data from Station ST-5 (Miller Creek) is missing from the quarterly report recently submitted. Our files indicate March, 1980 as the last date of sample collection. Perhaps this was an oversight and inadvertently left out of the report submitted to us. It has also been noted that the data for air and water temperatures from most stations is lacking. We would appreciate an updated copy of those missing data (April-June) at your earliest convenience.


Prior to approval of the location for the four new surface monitoring stations the Division would request a map delineating the exact location of
