RE: Contemporary Revegetation
Hiawatha Complex
King #6 Mine
ACT/007/011
Carbon County, Utah

On October 8, 1981, Lynn Kunzler of the Division staff met with Bob Eccli and Jean Semborski of U.S. Fuel Company to discuss apparent problems of revegetating a small area below the sediment pond at the King #6 Mine.

Before revegetation was to commence, a plan would need to be submitted to, and approved by the Division. This plan should include:

1. A statement that the area would be reclaimed in the future to the standards of an approved permanent reclamation plan.
2. The seed mix to be used in terms of Pure Live Seed.
3. Methods used to prepare the seedbed (including some type of tillage) and how it will be seeded.
4. Mulching techniques or justification for not using mulch.

These points were addressed verbally by Mr. Eccli and Ms. Semborski and they were instructed to submit the plan to the Division.
