Pursuant to U.S. Fuel Company's request for approval to construct a conveyor system, truck loadout and haulage road modification for the King #6 Mine area, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining and the Office of Surface Mining hereby issue joint approval for the proposed operations.

This approval is limited solely to the King #6 operational plan and does not constitute approval for the U. S. Fuel Company's Hiawatha Complex MRP submission which is still under review.


