Dear Ms. Semborski:

As per your request in a May 25, 1982 conversation, this letter is intended to document approval for additional storage of topsoil at the Lambs trailer location (a previously approved topsoil storage location). This approval is specifically for soil material previously stored at the upper mine yard associated with the King VI mine. It does not include approval for storage of other soils in this location unless the storage of other soils in this area is subsequently approved.

As discussed in the above-mentioned conversation, the approval is contingent on all conditions delineated in the December 14, 1981 letter. The only allowable deviation from this is the depth on #1 and the date on #6. The depth may be increased so as to preclude additional surface but is not to exceed 10 feet.

This approval is contingent on the following stipulations:

Stipulation #5-26-82-1-tp

Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this approval letter, the operator shall submit plans directed at achieving protection of the stockpile for the time period elapsing prior to the successful establishment of a vegetative cover capable of protecting the topsoil stockpile against erosion, from wind or water. Such plans shall be implemented within ten (10) days of the receipt of said approval.


Stipulation #5-26-82-2-tp
