Dear Mr. Hedberg:

In your July 11, 1985 letter to U.S. Fuel Company, the Division made a determination that additional, supplemental revegetation was necessary on the north bank of the Miller Creek stream diversion. U.S. Fuel responded by asking if this site could be considered for use as borrow material which would consequently reduce this slope and possibly assist revegetation success.

The Division then requested certain information with regard to dates, reclamation and quantity of borrow at this site. Although a reclamation plan and calculations on quantities of borrow could be supplied at this time, we do not have a detailed timetable as to when this material would be needed. Therefore, we propose to commit to the Division's request to provide additional, supplemental revegetation for this site without adjusting the slope on the north side of the diversion.

U.S. Fuel Company will seed and hydromulch the 1.1 acre area from the stream crossing on the east to the western extent of the

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of the realigned channel between mid-October and November 1, 1985. The seed mix and mulch application will consist of that recommended to us by your July 11, 1985 letter containing Lynn Kunzler's memo. The designated seedlings will be planted in the spring of 1986.

We expect this will satisfy the Division's request for a commitment to provide additional revegetation for this final reclamation area, (i.e. we do not plan any additional disturbance of this site).
