RE: Hiawatha Complex, U.S. Fuel Company, ACT/007/011, Folder #7, Carbon County, Utah

A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on May 1, 1985, by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector checked into the office but mine personnel were not able to accompany the inspector. The purpose of the visit was to view the abatement plans for NOV 84-8-1-3, #3 of 3. This involves implementing the plan for an emergency spillway at the North Fork diversion.

A letter was sent to the Division dated April 23, 1985 requesting an extension to the May 1, 1985 deadline. The letter stated that the road was still inaccessible due to snow and mud and that the company wanted an extension until June 15, 1985 to complete the work.

A site inspection was made at this time to determine the need for an extension. The road was accessible and when the inspector arrived at the site he found the contractor on site doing the necessary work. The contractor was awaiting one last load of rock when the inspector departed. It seemed that the work was acceptable although the final termination will be up to the issuing inspector.

On exiting the mine site, the inspector viewed the Morhland track spur including the emergency pipe discharge under the tracks. This area was permitted as an NPDES discharge point as a result of the previous inspector. No problems were found at this time.
