A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on March 13, 1985 by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Jean Semborski of U. S. Fuel Company. The purpose of the inspection was to inspect culverts and ditches to insure compliance during the runoff season.

Ditches and conveyances which have had a history of problems in the past were viewed at this time at both the Middle Fork and South Fork areas. No problems were noted during the inspections and all melting snow was running appropriately.

The ditch under the conveyor at the South Fork road looked more functional than during the previous inspection and the snow from a recent storm was plowed satisfactorily at the South Fork loadout (slotted drain) site.

No violations were warrented at this time.
