RE: Abatement Plans, Notice of Violation N84-4-8-8, #8 of 8, Middle Fork Road Drainage and Erosion Control, U. S. Fuel Company, Hiawatha Complex, ACT/007/011, #3 and #7, Carbon County, Utah

As per a telephone conversation with U. S. Fuel Company May 2, 1985, the Company has requested to begin immediate construction on Middle Fork Road Drainage in accordance with the abatement plans submitted in response to Notice of Violation (NOV) N84-4-8-8, #8 of 8. The Company has stated that a contractor is on site to begin work immediately.

The Division will provide approval for U. S. Fuel Company to begin construction on the culvert outlet downspouts and check dams as outlined in the abatement plan submitted December 14, 1984 to the Division. The sediment ponds outlined in the plan are not required.


However, the Division will not allow the use of flexible downspouts as energy dissipators, but require the use of rigid downspouts in construction with slash basins instead. The splash basin design must be similar to designs described in the abatement plan.

The Company must realize that these measures will not fully abatement NOV N84-4-8-8, #8 of 8. The Division will make a site visit in the future to address the final concerns to fully abate the NOV.
