The application for sampling the salt storage area (Area C) submitted by U. S. Fuel on January 21, 1985 has been reviewed by the Division. The proposed sampling plans are acceptable and approval is hereby granted by the Division for both the plans and the time frames.

As you will recall this sampling was required as part of an on-going investigation aimed at delineating the extent of salt and sodium contamination. This investigation resulted from original soils data submitted to abate the above violation.


The plans must be implemented (i.e. sampling must be done) prior to May 15, 1985. A report containing test data, interpretation and proposed mitigation plans (if applicable) shall be provided to the Division prior to July 1, 1985. Extensions must be approved prior to the implementation deadline.
