RE: Underground Mine Plan Sequence Change, Hiawatha Complex, King #6 Mine, U.S. Fuels Company, ACT/007/011, Folders #3 and #4, Carbon County, Utah

Proposal:

U. S. Fuel Company submitted plans to change the mining sequence in their King #6 Mine, due to uncontrollable roof and rib conditions.

Most of the mining will take place as previously planned. Mining from 1986 to 1992 will occur south of the original plans and create entries along old workings which will enable U. S. Fuel Company to access the major reserves from the western part of the mine.

Summary-Recommendations:

These changes will not cause additional adverse effects in excess of the original mine plan. Approval of these plans is recommended based on the information received.
