During a site inspection on December 5, 1986, Division inspector Holland Shepherd noted that the area disturbed by construction of the Cedar Creek Diversion and associated pipeline had been adequately reclaimed as per the Division's conditional approval (letter dated August 25, 1981). It is our understanding, that U. S. Fuel does not have any immediate plans or need to use this water supply for culinary purposes.

U. S. Fuel has agreed to obtain a permit from the Department of Health prior to using the water for culinary purposes, thus meeting the intent of the condition for Department of Health sign off. Therefore, the Division hereby grants final approval of this revision to your mine permit. Please provide a copy of the approval notice from the Health Department upon your receipt of same.
