Re: Conditional Approval of MRP Amendment, Request to Modify Water Supply Pipeline System, U.S. Fuel Company, Hiawatha Complex, ACT/007/011-86D, Carbon County, Utah

The application for MRP Permit Amendment submitted by U.S. Fuel Company on July 28, 1986 has been reviewed by the Division. The project involves a new water diversion point, and an 800 foot extension of an existing six-inch (6") water pipeline system in order to utilize allocated water from Cedar Creek. The proposed plans are acceptable and conditional approval is hereby granted by the Division to proceed with implementation. Seeding of disturbed areas on the project must be completed by October 30, 1986.

Because the pipeline involves water intended for culinary use, this approval is contingent on the operator obtaining written approval from the State Division of Environmental Health, Bureau of Public Water Supplies.
