~~Lynn Kunzler~~ of your staff recently requested information on Special Federal Condition No. 13 of the Federal Permit No. UT-0006 for U.S. Fuel Company's Hiawatha Mines Complex. This condition required compliance with the Reclamation Fee Installment Agreement of November 15, 1985, between U.S. Fuel Company and the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE). On May 6, 1987, the Solicitor's Office, Division of Surface Mining, informed this office that, according to OSMRE's records, two of the payments had not been made. U.S. Fuel Company was asked to submit copies of all cancelled checks for the Reclamation Fee Installments as proof that the payments had been made. They submitted this information on May 11, 1987, therefore, they are considered to be in compliance with Condition No. 13. This office has transmitted copies of the checks to OSMRE Headquarters so that our records can be updated, and is maintaining copies of the checks here, as well, in case a question arises in the future.
