Re: Conditional Approval of Abatement Plans For NOV-N87-17-4-4, 3 of 4, Hiawatha Complex, ACT/007/011, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has reviewed the plans submitted on August 27, 1987, to modify the Middle Fork Sediment pond. This revision is hereby approved under the following conditions:

Condition #1 - RS

The operator will construct the spillage structures (primary and emergency) according to the existing permit relative to capacity (dimensions) and erosional stability. Maps, plans and cross-sections must be certified as per UMC 784.23(c)(1). Pursuant to UMC 817.49(h) a certification report must be made and submitted to the Division within 30 days after construction.


Condition #2 - LK
