Dear Mr. Braxton;

In accordance with the meeting held March 25, 1988 between U.S. Fuel and DOGM, U.S. Fuel Company agrees to the following:

U.S. Fuel will install up to three additional water bars on the Mohrland road in locations mutually agreed upon.

U.S. Fuel will inspect the pipeline in the Mohrland area at least twice a week during the critical seasons, i.e. late fall and early spring and once per week during less critical times of the year.

U.S. Fuel will make a record of all inspections and breaks in the pipe.

U.S. Fuel will repair leaks as expeditiously as possible and road damage caused by a leak will be fully repaired as weather conditions permit.

The Division retains the right to take appropriate action in the event of gross negligence on the part of the operator in fulfilling this agreement. However, before issuing a N.O.V., U.S. Fuel would be notified verbally and in writing of their negligence in these commitments and given opportunity to respond.



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U.S. Fuel will not be held responsible for problems resulting from activities conducted by other parties, such as Emery County Road Department or climatic events. The Emery County Road Department will be notified of this agreement to seek their cooperation.
