On December 24, 1987, the Division received a copy of U. S. Fuel Company's request for a minor underground mine plan modification at the King No. 6 Mine. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) approved the proposal on December 22, 1987. David Darby, Reclamation Geologist, and J. Randall Harden, Reclamation Engineer, have reviewed the plan. The proposal will extend the second west entries from the current mine workings to the centerline of Section 31.

These changes are consistent with typical mining practices and will not constitute major changes to the original approved mine plan.
