RE: Crushing and Screening Facility


Dear Sue:

In February of 1989, U.S. Fuel received final approval to allow Genwal to operate a temporary crushing and screening facility within the U.S. Fuel permit area. This approval is scheduled to expire on August 27, 1989 and requires that all equipment be removed from the site by September 4, 1989.

It now appears that Genwal's new facilities will not be ready by that date. Therefore, we would like to obtain an extension of time in order to allow the facility to continue to operate at Hiawatha while the necessary arrangements are made at the permanent site. We suggest that the deadline be extended until December 30, 1989 in order to allow sufficient time for the work to be done.

The crushing and screening facility is within a disturbed area with suitable sediment control structures in place. No environmental degradation would occur should this facility continue to operate until the end of the year. We would appreciate your assistance with matter.
