SUMMARY:

Stipulations regarding the conditional approval for modifications to the Middle Fork Loadout Facilities were recieved on April 27, 1989 by the operator.

ANALYSIS:

U.S. Fuel has submitted a Notice of Intent to modify a coal loadout facility with the Department of Health, dated March 1, 1989. It appears that the information submitted to Health is sufficient for review by that Agency. The stipulation response by the operator however, does not include approval or response by the Department of Health. Approval for construction of these facilities will be considered upon acceptance by Air Quality.

The operator should notify the Division upon receipt of approval by Health and forward a copy of the approval to the Division.

Information requested by the Division regarding the facilities was made in a memo dated March 29, 1989. This information has been included in the stipulation response by the operator and is considered adequate.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

U.S. Fuels Company is in compliance with the requirements of the regulations regarding the description of the proposed loadout facilities. Upon approval by Heath, and notification of approval to the Division, the operator can commence construction of those facilities.
