RE: Amendment, Water Monitoring Change, United States Fuel Company, Hiawatha Mine Complex, ACT/007/011-88E, Carbon County, Utah, Folder # 2.

## Synopsis

During 1988 U. S. Fuel Company requested three separate amendments to their surface and ground water monitoring program. The requests are dated March 31, 1988 for ACT/007/011-88A, August 12, 1988 for ACT/007/011-88D and October 25, 1988 for ACT/007/011-88E. The requests were reviewed and approved with requirements that tables and maps be updated to reflect changes for parameters and monitoring frequency.

## Conclusion

U. S. Fuel Company submitted the revised water monitoring program on December 21, 1988 which incorporated the all the changes requested in the above mentioned amendments. The materials supplied by U. S. Fuel Company incorporates and addresses all the information requested in the three amendment requests.

## Recommendation

I recommend that final approval be granted to U. S. Fuel Company for amendments ACT/007/011-88A, ACT/007/011-88D and ACT/007/011-88E and to allow the information submitted December 21, 1988 (revised December 2, 1988) to be incorporated into their Permit Application Package.
