3. Topsoil -

The topsoil piles were inspected for erosion from wind and water. The berms were intact with no breaches apparent. The topsoil piles have vegetation which help to prevent wind erosion.

4b. Diversions -

Several diversions were inspected and were in compliance with the performance standards.

4c. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments -

Sediment ponds were inspected for termination of NOV 91-39-7-2 part 2 of 2 which was for erosion to the inlet of the sediment ponds. U.S. Fuel Co. installed elephant trunks to culverts inlets and added rip rap to the diversion ditches entering the ponds. The NOV was terminated after inspection of the ponds.

4d. Other Sediment Control Measures -

The Savage Truck shop area was given an NOV 91-39-7-2 part 1 of 2 for not having design criteria for this alternative control area. The designs have been sent to DOGM in Salt Lake for review. An extension was granted at the request of the operator for Division review.
