1. Permit -

- a. The Savage truck yard does not report to a sediment pond, has not been approved as an SAE or an ASCA in the outstanding permit. Therefore, an NOV 91-39-7-2 violation #1 was written.
- b. All inspections for refuse piles, slurry pond and water sampling were performed according to the mine plan. No problems were noted.
- c. Bonding and insurance were up to date with no problems noted.

3. Topsoil -

The topsoil pile was inspected. Berms were intact and a good stand of vegetation was observed on the topsoil pile.

4c. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments -

The sediment ponds were inspected and four ponds had excess erosion to the inlets due to several storms occurring in early August. Therefore, NOV 91-39-7-2 violation #2 was issued.

7. Coal Processing Waste -

During the last OSM oversight, an NOV 91-39-1-4 was written on slurry pond #5 for not having siltation structures for drainage. OSM advised the undersigned that the aforementioned NOV is under review. The issue concerns the embankment to determine if it is pre-law.

\*\*An AVS check showed that no new changes have occurred since the last inspection.
