

Dear Daron:

This is to request an extension of time in which to submit revised Chapter VII (Bonding) of our Mid Permit Term Review. This is the final chapter of the revision requirement. All other chapters have been submitted.

The deadline for completion of the permit revisions was originally set at August 30. The chapter on Bonding was scheduled to be addressed during the months of July and August, however, Company reorganization, personnel reductions and office relocations caused significant delays earlier in the year and forced us to use that time to complete Chapter VII (Hydrology) which was due at the end of June.

I am requesting an extension to November 14 for submittal of this final chapter. That is 120 days prior to our permit expiration date of March 14, 1992. Although this is not a large chapter considerable map revisions and earth work volume calculations will be required due to changes in surface configurations of slurry ponds and refuse disposal sites. Other permit related projects such as plan submittals to address recent OSM violations, fall water monitoring, and field work required for subsidence monitoring must also be completed during this time.
