I am aware that the DOGM may find it advantageous to utilize the United States Fuel Co. #5 slurry pond as a disposal site for approximately 8000 yards of coal refuse from the Mohrland Mine. Although the U. S. Fuel property appears to be in the final stages of being sold, both U. S. Fuel and the prospective purchasers are in agreement that the DOGM is welcome to dispose of the Mohrland refuse in the slurry pond this year (at no charge) providing, of course, that the material will not create additional reclamation liabilities or permit conflicts.
