On May 1, 1997, assignments of the above referenced coal leases, entered into on April 30, 1997 between C.O.P. Coal Development Company (C.O.P.), as assignee, and Intermountain Power Agency (IPA), as assignor, were filed in this office.

Satisfactory evidence of the qualifications and holdings of C.O.P. has been filed. This office has received no evidence that the leases are not in good standing. The assignee, C.O.P., has submitted a statement, executed on April 30, 1997, that it hereby accepts the assignments of the subject leases and agrees hereafter to keep and perform all of the assignor's covenants and obligations pursuant thereto. Therefore, the assignments appear to meet the requirements of the regulations and are approved effective July 1, 1997. Approval of these assignments does not constitute approval of any of the terms therein which may be in violation of the lease terms.

Bond coverage for coal lease U-61048 is satisfied by a personal bond of \$5,000 secured by a United States Treasury Note. Bond coverage for coal lease U-61049 is satisfied by a personal bond of \$7,000 secured by a United States Treasury Note. The bonds were filed June 27, 1997, and are accepted as of that date.
