I have review all current U.S. Fuel submittals to the Division regarding Division Order (DO) 97A. To this point they have satisfied two hydrologic issues through approved amendments 97a and 97b, and one through their May 20 response to the DO. Remaining issues are R645-301-742.110 under the operational plan and all under the reclamation plan.

The most recent submittal included textual changes to section R645-301-732. These changes involve the reclassification of non-pond treated areas from small area exemptions (SAEs) to alternate sediment control areas (ASCAs). These changes are complete and per the requirements of the regulations and technical directive Tech-003A.
