On April 26, 2000, the Division approved amendment 00A. This amendment adds the stream alteration permit for North Fork to the mining and reclamation plan.

8. Noncoal Waste

Near the shop building near the cemetery, there is some noncoal waste that needs to be cleaned up. It's not a serious problem but needs to be taken care of.

13. Revegetation

The previous report mentions there is some kochia in the reclaimed areas and that I had not seen kochia at this mine before. We saw remnants of last year's growth, so I had obviously just missed it.


