SUMMARY:

On July 6, 2000, the Division received a proposal to update the ownership and control information in the Hiawatha mining and reclamation plan. This was in response to a request from the Division after comparing the information in the annual report with information in the plan. On July 25, 2000, the Division requested by electronic mail that the permittee also update some information with regard to ownership of the coal leases. The Division received a response by electronic mail on July 26, 2000, with an attached document including a cover letter, C1 and C2 forms, and the submittal in Adobe Acrobat format. Another revision to the amendment was received, also electronically, on October 5, 2000.

Analysis:

The applicant has changed the list of officers authorized to act on behalf of ANR Company, Inc. The application includes the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of ANR's officers together with the dates they assumed their positions. This information appears to be complete and comply with the ownership and control requirements of the regulations.

TECHNICAL MEMO

The plan formerly indicated Hiawatha Coal Company was in the process of obtaining leases from U. S Fuel Company, but Hiawatha Coal now has these leases and has received approval from the Bureau of Land Management. The application updates the plan accordingly.

Findings:
