1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

CW mining will become the controlling entity for the Hiawatha Mine. The permittee will submit an amendment to the Division for the change.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS

Signs were present at the entrance to the mine.

4B. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS

Pond 1 and Pond 4 had minor amounts of water in them. The permittee had not yet done the quarterly inspections for the ponds. The permit had done all the inspections for the ponds in 2000.

4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING

The water monitoring data for 2000 had been submitted to the Division. The data had some minor problems that were being corrected.

4E. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS

No effluent limit violations were reported.

5. EXPLOSIVES

No explosives were stored on site. The permittee is insured for damage from explosives.

7. COAL MINE WASTE/REFUSE PILES/IMPOUNDMENTS

The permittee was reminded to submit an amendment that would allow coal mine waste from the Bear Canyon Mine to be disposed of at the Hiawatha mine.

12. BACKFILLING AND GRADING

The permittee plans on completing the backfilling and grading in the Pond 4 area when the ground dries.

13. REVEGETATION

The permittee may seed the reclaimed areas this spring if weather conditions permit. If not, they will seed in the fall.

14. SUBSIDENCE CONTROL

The 2000 subsidence report was done by an aerial survey company. The report was in the mail.
