Hello Charles,

I wanted to let you know that I changed the status of UPDES locations 010, and 013 in the database so they would not show up as locations I am required to evaluate each quarter. They are still in the database, not deleted - just deactivated. I did not want to deactivate 012, since it is still measured in case there are repairs made to the Mohrland pipeline.

I also see that the 4th quarter 2012 surface water locations and UPDES 001 and 002 are in the pipeline waiting on you folks to check them off as ready to upload. As far as requiring UPDES 003-009 and 012 to be in the database, we'll have to wait to see what Dana decides.

Dana,

I have been checking the data that is coming into the database from the Hiawatha mine. In light of the number of violations, I have been trying to do this before the end of the following quarter due date to identify any issues with missing samples so you can have the opportunity to make corrections (if possible).

According to Table 7-17 in the Mine Plan, field parameters are required for the month of October during the 4th quarter for all stream samples. I did not see any October data from the stream locations when I uploaded the data. Were field samples collected in October? If the data inadvertently did not get entered, you still have until the end of first quarter (March 31) to get it to us. If it was not collected, then that is another violation of your permit.

I am hoping we can discuss the issues surrounding QA/QC and the collection of data when you come in for the assessment conference on February 6th. I am always a phone call away if you have questions about uploading data to the pipeline, or sample collection in general.

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The 4th quarter water data has been entered into the pipeline & is ready for you to upload.
