Report summary and status for pending enforcement actions, permit conditions, Division Orders, and amendments:

Visited the refuse pile area, South Fork and Middle Fork during the partial inspection.

Evidence is still apparent of the large storms received in 2014, exasperated by the wild fires. Rocks, wood and sediment id large volumes has impacted the mine site. These same features were present during the midterm review. An additional storm and impacts occurred after that visit. The operator has most diversions re-opened. Work still needs to be done especially in sediment ponds when the material dries out.

Site is not in active operation. The site is locked up and access to the site is gained by contacting the operator. The site is an older mine site and is geographic spread out over a large area.

2. Signs and Markers

Mine identification signs are posted at entrances into the mining permit area. The signs are plate metal that have the required information laser cut into them. The signs are compliant.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The diversion around the base of the refuse pile needs areas re-defined. Pieces of metal were observed in the road diversion of middle fork, These items should be removed from the diversion.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The sediment pond in middle fork canyon needs to be cleaned from the storms/fire impacts from previous year. The pond contains water and was actively receiving runoff during the inspection.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

Asphalt surfaces throughout the site are de-graded, but travelable. Portions have been impacted from sediment over flow from large storm/fire events.
