2. Signs and Markers

Mine identification signs are posted at both access points into the mining permit area. These signs both contain the required information are in compliance with the coal rules.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Diversions are snow covered and many are not visible due to the snow.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The sediment pond clean in south fork is suspended due to weather and is slated to begin in the spring.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

Refuse pile appeared stable. No visible hazards were noticed during the inspection.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

The majority of the roads have been plowed to removed excess snow. Many of the roads are still snow packed with three to four inches of snow. Travel is possible at reduced speeds and four wheel drive.
