2. Signs and Markers

Identifications signs are located at two different points along the county road used to access the Hiawatha mine site. The signs are located at points here the permit area boundary begins. The signs contained the name, address, phone number and mining permit number as fulfilling the requirements set forth by law. The signs are in compliance.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile was accessible by road where the majority of the remaining property is inaccessible due to the volume of snow laid upon the ground surface. The refuse pile appeared stable. No visible hazards. The refuse pile is still snow covered. The pile has an identification sign as required by law.
