Eureka Energy Company herewith amends it's Notice of Intention dated June 6, 1980, to include the following information required pursuant to Rule M-3(5)d.

The disturbance in the Fish Creek area consists of an access road cut in a steeply sloping, boulder strewn series of rock ledges. The road is not amenable to restoration to original contour. It is intended to leave the road at the present contour as a protection to the lower valley from rolling rocks. The portions of the road on federal land shall be reseeded. The private lengths of the road shall be left for use as an observation point for the planning engineers. Restoration will be done during the final reclamation at the end of the project.


The disturbance in Dugout Canyon will consist of an access road crossing private (Eureka) land and terminating on federal land at the drill site. Flat sections of the road and the drill site will be cleared with minimal disturbance. In areas where the road will be cut into steep slopes regrading will be done by inducing the upper side to slough, raking with the back hoe and then re-seeding. Trenched areas will be on private land and will be held open for observation by the planning engineers. Trenches will be reclaimed at the project end with the general reclamation.

The reseeded will be by hand casting to be carried out in October or early November. The seed mix to be used will be :

Great Basin Wildrye	Rate	5 lbs./ac.
Bulbous Bluegrass	Rate	5 lbs./ac.
Gambel Oak	Rate	1 lb. /ac.
Woods Rose	Rate	1 lb. /ac.
