

On September 17, 1980 an inspection was made of the Wellington Prep Plant by Office of Surface Mining and Division of Oil, Gas and Mining representatives, Larry Damrau and D. Wayne Hedberg. Mr. Bill Kurtwood, Plant Superintendent, accompanied the inspectors on the inspection of the loadout facilities.

A major portion of the surface facilities and the drainage systems were inspected for compliance. One diversion culvert close to the plant was 3/4 plugged with sediment and will be cleaned promptly.

The tailings ponds were also inspected and the recycling process explained by Mr. Kurtwood. An emergency discharge device was noted in the lowest settling pond. Mr. Kurtwood stated that no discharge has or will occur, therefore no N.P.D.E.S. permit is required.

No federal or state violations were issued.
