On March 26, 1980 Mary Ann Wright of the Division visited these sites. Messrs. Glen Sides and Randy Watts from U.S. Steel and Mr. Clark Johnson from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and Mr. Larry Dalton of the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources accompanied on this visit. The purpose of this visit was for a wildlife consultation.

Both Mr. Dalton and Mr. Johnson seemed to concur that the existing information for these sites should be sufficient for inclusion into the mining plan for the Permanent Program. Since no new disturbance is planned for either of these areas it seems unnecessary to engage in any field studies for wildlife.

Several comments were made by Mr. Johnson concerning enhancement plans utilizing the existence of the riparian habitat at the Wellington Coal Preparation Plant along the Price River.

Mr. Dalton was supplied with three sets of maps for this site.
