Dear Mr. Smith:

The Preservation Office has received the mine plan for the U.S. Steel Corporation, Wellington Preparation Plan, ACT/007/012, Carbon County, Utah. As outlined by the memorandum of agreement between the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, and the Division of State History, our staff has reviewed this mine plan for the Wellington Preparation Plant.

The plant is located southeast of Wellington about two miles and is an existing plant which was completed in 1958. The report notes that there are not sites of historic value on the property, and that expansion of the plant will be limited to expansion of the refuse disposal areas. In agreement with the mine plan, and the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, it is unlikely that there are any cultural sites in the area or any that would be affected by the development of the Wellington Preparation Plant.
