All future oil and grease samples will be capped with teflon coated or foil lined lids after collection. Ford Chemical Laboratory has been notified and will furnish the proper sample bottles immediately.

The BOD₅ and Total Suspended Solids composite samples collected from Outfall 003 are now being refrigerated during compositing.
