Dear Ms. Storrud:

The following is U. S. Steel Mining Co.'s response to the subject stipulations:

Stipulation 9-29-83-1-TP

U. S. Steel Mining Co. accepts the stipulation; however, 30 days is requested to supply the volumes of the soil embankments.

Stipulation 9-29-83-2-TP

The subsoil will be stored separately at the topsoil pile location designated on Drawing E9-3425.

Stipulation 9-29-83-3-TP

The topsoil and subsoil stockpiles will be mulched with straw mulch. The stockpiles will be seeded with the following mix:

<u>Species</u>	<u>Lbs Per Acre</u>
Alkali Sacaton	1 lb
Yellow Sweetclover	3 lbs
Tall Wheatgrass	6 lbs
Western Wheatgrass	4 lbs

Ms. Shannon Storrud
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U. S. Steel Mining Co. has contracted with Rollins, Brown and Gunnell, Inc. to monitor construction of the refuse dike and verify that embankment is properly compacted.
