The Wellington Prep Plant complex was visited in the afternoon of Monday, January 31 by the technical staff review team assigned to this project (Lynn Kunzler, Shannon Storrud, Joe Lyons, Rick Summers and Doug Maier - Tom Portle was absent). The purpose of the visit was to familiarize these individuals with the operation prior to the permit application ACR (Apparent Completeness Review) which is scheduled for completion in mid-April 1983. Company officials in attendance were Glenn Sides and Randy Watts.

Conditions were cold and wet, with scattered snow cover, but all sites of interest were accessible and visible. Areas and facilities that were observed included the following: (1) coal cleaning plant; (2) coarse refuse pile; (3) fine refuse pile. Of major concern and which will require further field investigation is uncontrolled processing water that is discharging from the plant. This was followed to an area of dissipation in close proximity to the Price River.
