Dear Mr. Yourston:

Before the Division can approve your request to install a natural gas pipeline adjacent to the plant access road, the following information must be supplied:

1. A map (scale 1:2000 or larger) showing the exact location of the pipeline (a commitment to submit this map with the response to the ACR for the Wellington Prep Plant would suffice).
2. More detail regarding the type of pipe (PVC, steel, etc.) and the burial depth.
3. Plans for reclamation (will pipe be removed?), and temporary stabilization as per UMC 784.13 and 817.100.
