Dear Ms. Linner:

Per your conversation with V. R. Watts of this office, the following information is submitted:

In the revisions to the permanent permit application submitted July 7, 1983, portions of an area leased to Utah Power and Light were deleted from the permit area for the following reasons:

1. The area was included in the permit area in the original submittal in area.
2. To our knowledge this area has never been used to support operations at the Wellington Coal Cleaning Plant. No portion of this area has been used by United States Steel Corporation or U. S. Steel Mining Co., Inc. since its lease to Utah Power and Light.
3. A brief history of the lease follows:

	<u>Acreage</u>	<u>Date</u>
Original Lease	20	June 1, 1972
Ammended Lease	102	June 16, 1975
Renewal for 5 Years	102	June 1, 1982

The lease currently extends until 1987 and may be renewed for an additional 5 years.

4. The railroad spur and site grading were performed by Utah Power and Light.

Since the area has not been used by the Wellington Coal Cleaning Plant and has been under the lease and control of Utah Power and Light since 1972, this area should not be included within our permit area.
