On April 11, 1984, Susan Linner, Tom Tetting, and Wayne Hedberg of the Division and Steve McNeal of the Division of Environmental Health visited the Wellington Preparation Plant near Wellington, Utah. We were accompanied by Bill Kirkwood and Barb Filas of U. S. Steel. The main purpose of the visit was to allow Mr. McNeil to view the sedimentation and slurry pond systems at the plant, to finalize his review of the mining permit application. The new Heat Dryer and Road ponds were visited. Neither one are finished or fully functional as of this time. Mr. McNeil was also concerned about the sewage system and that was viewed. The slurry ponds, clear water pond and new berm around the topsoil storage pile were also viewed.
