**NOTICE OF DECISION**  
Pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq.) and the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities" (Final Rules of the Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining), the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has issued a permit to process coal to U. S. Steel Mining Company, Inc. for its permit application No. ACT/007/012. The Company will process coal in accordance with the approved Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Wellington Preparation Plant associated with the following lands:
